- **MODULE 1 : Regulatory context around animal protection during the maritime transport of live animals**

- **MODULE 3 : Theoretical Scenario**
 - Loading cattle by the yard and by the footbridge / Loading of sheep by the footbridge
 - Emergency
 - Exchanges between trainees on their work practices: identification of risky practices and corrective actions with synthesis of recommendations
