

TRAINING PROGRAM Animal handling and welfare on board ships

Objective of the training:

- Be able to cite key points in regulations concerning the transport and handling of animals
- Know the fundamentals of animal handling
- Being able to define animal welfare
- Be able to carry out the "welfare monitoring" of the animals during the crossing

Audience: Any person required to handle animals on vessels

Prerequisites: None **Duration:** 4 hours
